
Today's Kalam Foundation was started in the year 2016 in Hyderabad by a group of intellectuals with the inspiration of A.P.J Abdul Kalam.

KALAM CENTERS

At first glance, Hyderabad reminds us of everything that is good in a metropolis: the IT sector at HITEC City and the old charm of Charminar, the Falaknama Palace, Golconda fort etc. But there is more than what meets the eye. According to the 2011 Census, one-third of Hyderabad's population lives in slums. Over 1179 slums have been officially identified by GHMC. The slum population is growing at a rate of 6.06% per annum.

Much of this is concentrated in the Old City, Hyderabad where living conditions remain abysmal. With hardly any industry, the primary sources of livelihood include housekeeping, autorickshaws, blue-collared work and street vending.



The congested habitations and living conditions make academic excellence a challenge. Education is discontinued at a young age for most children due to financial constraints and safety concerns. The kids who drop out are involved in household chores, child labour, child marriages etc.

We had seen the advantages of a good education first-hand and wanted similar opportunities to be open for all children in the Old City. To make this a reality, Now we have 3 employees and over 50 volunteers.

To reach out to kids who don't get the opportunity to attend schools, Today's Kalam volunteers visit slum areas and identify student groups. Under Graduates and Post, Graduates are selected as mentors and a Kalam Centre is established in a local hall or a study space. Each center focuses on empowering 30 children. The children visit the center every day for two hours to learn basic reading and writing skills and arithmetic calculations. There is a special focus on health and hygiene, nutrition awareness and career counselling. They also teach self-defence, sports, vocational training and other extracurricular activities. The Kalam centers ensure that children are always updated on general knowledge including political, geographical and international issues, advances of applied sciences and the advantages of technology. Attendance is recorded every day. Important national festivals like Independence Day, Republic Day etc are celebrated with guests.

OPEN TENTH CLASS

We are focusing on underprivileged children in Hyderabad and reduce the consequences of lack of education. We plan to serves as a bridge between elementary and higher education and prepare young persons between the age group of 14-18 for entry into higher education.-- for that we select students for Open Tenth Exam 2021

On Independence Day, 53 members attended the talk online Aditya kesanupalli gave his words on Independence day.







Food kits from Kalam Foundation

The non-profit organisation distributed rice, dal and cooking oil to needy families

n a bid to help the homeless and needy people in coping with the lockdown that is being enforced across the country to contain the spread of Covid-19, Hyderabad-based Today's Kalam Foundation has come out to distribute food kits containing rice, dal and cooking oil to the families in need. Arshad Shaik, president of the foundation, says, "It is our responsibility to ensure that no family faces hardship during this moment

of crisis, especially daily wagers. We've started this initiative since the lockdown was announced. So far, our foundation has distributed around 50 food kits and our target is to reach nearly 2,000 families." Each kit costs about Rs 1,000. The foundation is planning to collect funds through various means to reach the target. It has also started a crowdfunding campaign on Milaap for financial support for 1,000 ration kits. The foundation primarily runs centres at Old City.

NGO distributes food kits to daily wagers

Mehdipatnam: In the times of lockdown, the daily wagers, who without any earning source were the hardest hit, found some respite on Friday after receiving food kits containing rice, dal and cooking oil for their entire families from a city-based NGO, Kalam Foundation.

According to Foundation president, Arshad Shaik, since the country has been locked down to arrest deadly Covid-19 outbreak, some families, specially of daily labourers, were the worst affected, with their livelihood at stake. "We have been catering to the educational needs of underprivi-

leged children in the slums of Hyderabad. In the face of crisis like this, we are aiming to distribute food kits to approximately 2,000 families," he said.

Most of the affected are civil workers, auto drivers, roadside vendors, workers in small factories, tailors, domestic belners, etc. he said.

"30 kits have already been distributed and the foundation is plannium to collect funds through various means to reach out to the target of 2,000 deserving and vulnerable famliles. Kalam Foundation has also started a crowdfunding campaign on Milaap forfinancial support for 1,000 ration kits," added Arshad.
